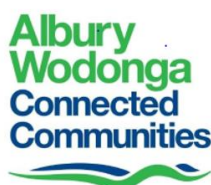

2022 Women's Rugby League Carnival
Rules and Regulations

1. It remains the responsibility of all clubs entering the Albury Women's Rugby League Carnival to obtain, where necessary, the permission from their respective League. It is also each club's responsibility to satisfy NSW Rugby League requirements regarding the lodgement of a security deposit if using overnight accommodation.
2. **Nominations** with the Albury Rugby League Football Club Inc (the organising committee) will close by last mail (5:00pm) **Wednesday 28th September 2022**. Teams nominating in the **Senior division** – players must be **17 or over** as per NSWRL regulations. Teams nominating in the **U16s division** – must be **born 2006-2007**; **U14s division** – must be **born 2008-2009**; **U12s division** – must be born **2010-2011**. (Please note a minimum of 4 teams will be required for the U14 & U12 divisions). Nominations should be emailed to: alburythunderrl@gmail.com
3. The **nomination fee of \$250/\$100** must accompany each entry. The nomination fee will be forfeited by teams not appearing to play as scheduled. Substitute teams can be added if a forfeit occurs after the draw is completed.
4. **All players must be registered to play Rugby League**. Players that are **not currently** registered tackle players will incur an additional fee for insurance cover of:
Senior player - \$80; 17/18-year-old - \$40; 16 & under \$20.
A registration link will be forwarded to each team when they have paid their entry fee.
5. **Nominations will be unlimited** in the Senior and Junior divisions. Each team will be given an entry number as received and placed into a playing pool. Each team will be scheduled to play a minimum of 4 games. The draw will be advised to entrants no later than Monday 3rd October 2022.
6. **Prize pool** to be awarded as follows:
 - a. Women's Winner: \$4,000 + vouchers (\$1,000); Runner Up: \$1,000 + vouchers (\$500)
 - b. Women's Semi Finalists: \$600
 - c. Women's Plate Winner: \$500; Women's Bowl Winner: \$400
 - d. U16 Winner: \$500 Voucher/Goods Package; U16 Runner Up: \$250 Voucher/Goods
 - e. U14 Winner: \$500 Voucher/Goods Package; U14 Runner Up: \$250 First Aid Supplies
 - f. U12 Winner: \$250 Medallions & First Aid Supplies; U12 Runner Up: Medallions
7. The competition will be conducted over 2 days, **Saturday 8th & Sunday 9th October 2022**. All games will be played at the **Lavington Sports Ground Complex no. 2 oval** and **Sarvass Park** or any other venue as decided by the organising committee.
8. All matches will consist of 2 x 9 minutes halves, with no time off for injury, except Semi-finals & Grand finals which will have time off for injury.
9. Each team entering may nominate up to 16 players, who must be registered with or approved by NSWRL to play in their nominated team. Clubs making false statements regarding the registration status of players will be immediately removed from the Carnival. Once a player has taken the field representing an entrant team, she must complete the Carnival representing that team.
10. Teams consist of nine (9) players on the field & seven (7) replacement players. A maximum of 16 players may be used in any game. Unlimited interchange applies.

11. **The organising committee will not be responsible for any medical, hospital, ambulance, or compensation claims incurred by any player participating in the carnival.**
12. All games will be controlled by Referees appointed by the Group 9 Referees Appointments Board. Referees from other Groups/Leagues will be invited to participate.
13. All protests, disputes and hearings for players sent from the field, will be dealt with by the organising committee Judiciary & Disputes Committee comprising two (2) members of the organising committee and one (1) other from the NSWRL, Group or visiting Club Official.
14. Any player citing must be in the hands of the organising committee within 1 hour of the conclusion of the game.
15. **Suspended players are NOT eligible** to play in the Carnival.
16. Players can only play for the team to which they have been registered. Teams will forfeit their game if they play a player not registered to their team.
17. All players will be required to sign a team sheet before taking the field.

Rules relating to drawn games in pool matches and semi-finals:

In the event of a draw the winner shall be –

1. The team scoring the most tries.
2. If tries are even the team scoring the first try.
3. If no tries are scored the team scoring the first penalty goal.

In the event of a scoreless game the result shall be decided as follows:

1. Least penalties conceded.
2. If penalties conceded are even, the team conceding the first penalty loses.

In the event of a draw in the **Grand Final**, the **Golden Point** rule will apply.
